Patience and Perseverance






While everyone starts to do their part...

How to be a patient commuter:

1 Do not be in such a hurry

Do not rush your way through the door. Allow other passengers to alight first and wait for your turn. You will eventually board the bus or train.



Stand on the left side of escalator

Stand on one side to allow others to move into the bus. Do not delay the journey of other passengers by blocking the way.

Be mindful of your behaviour

Avoid talking or laughing away loudly on public transport as it may disrupt other passengers.



Move to the back of the bus

Always move to the back of the bus so that more passengers can board the bus.


