



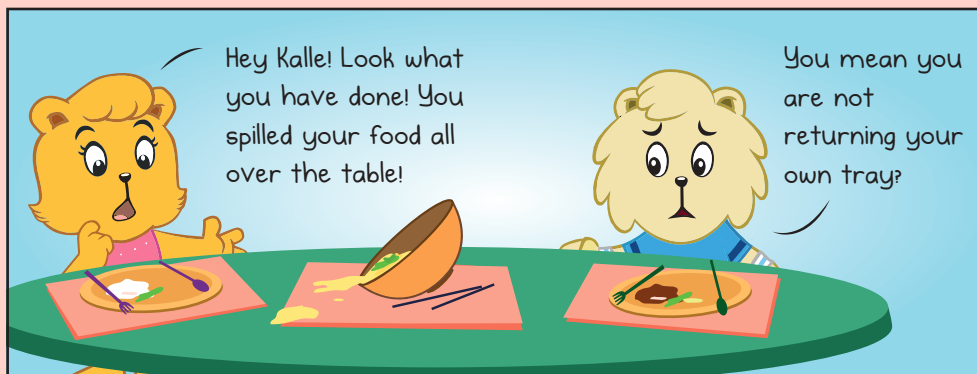

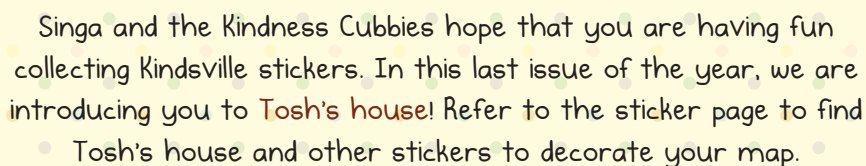


KEEPING KINDSVILLE CLEAN
