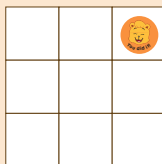
- 1 Decide on a Kindness Challenge for the week.

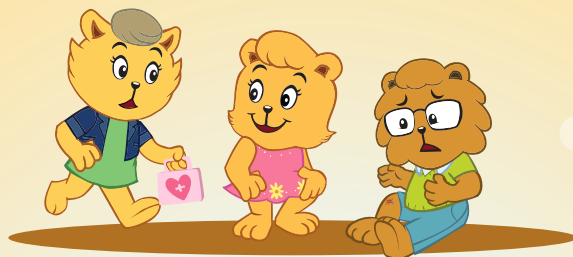
