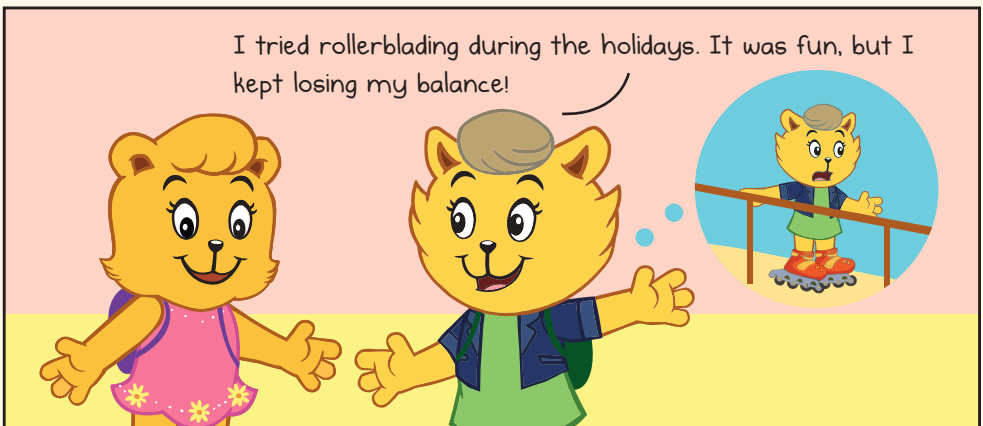


Sher is a big lover of daisies and a natural daydreamer. She is sweet and loves dolling up.

Good morning Tomeo! Nice to see you too! Did you have fun during your holidays?

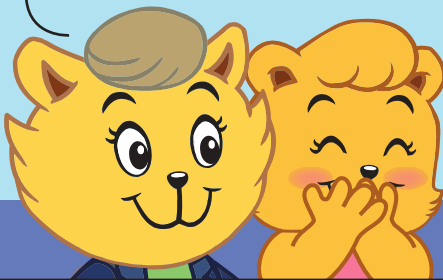


Oh yes, I prepared lots of delicious meals for my family. This morning, I had a hearty breakfast...

Obey classroom rules so that you and your friends can have a happy learning place. You can start by keeping the classroom clean! Be Kind, Keep Clean!



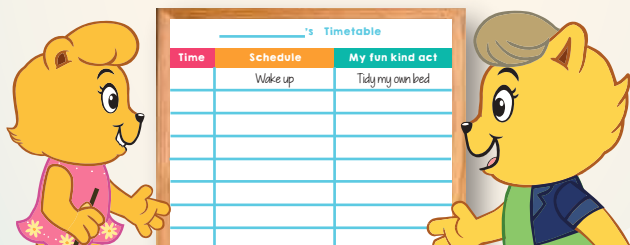
3 Eat and rest well

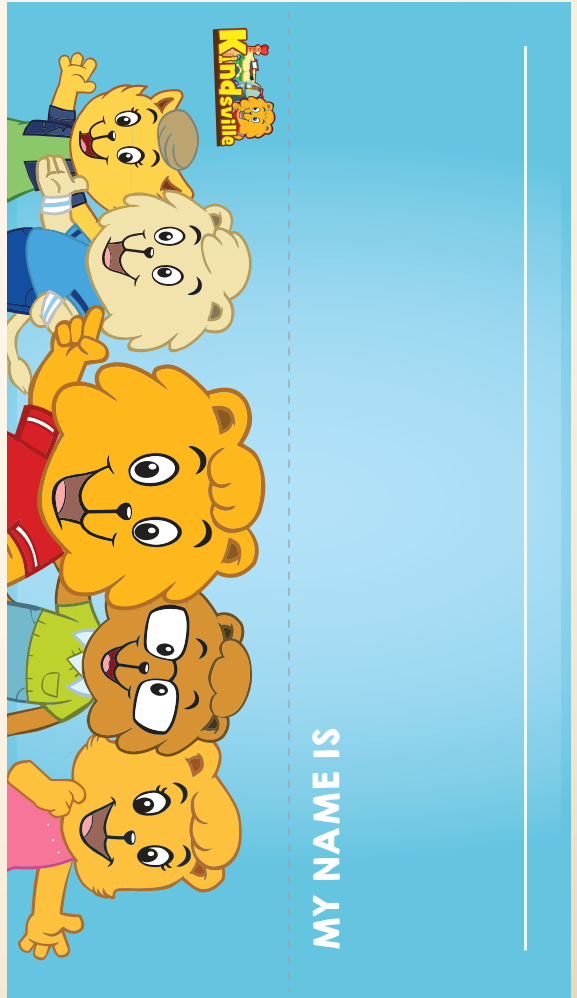

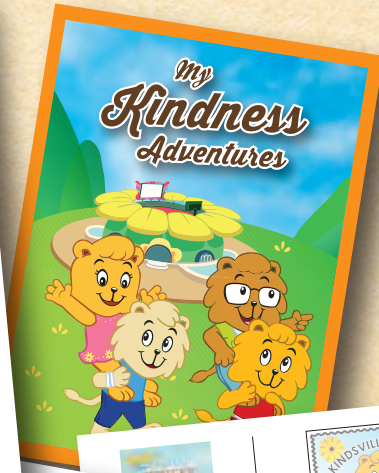
