Singa and the Kindness Cubbies are excited.

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


The train to the Town Hall arrives and the Cubbies board it.

Do you think it's right to eat and drink on the train? Why?




Just then, someone hurries across the train and accidentally bumps into Tomeo.

Five magic words: Thank you, You're welcome, Please, Excuse me, Sorry.




The backup power supply switches on, and the lights are back on. The train starts moving again.


