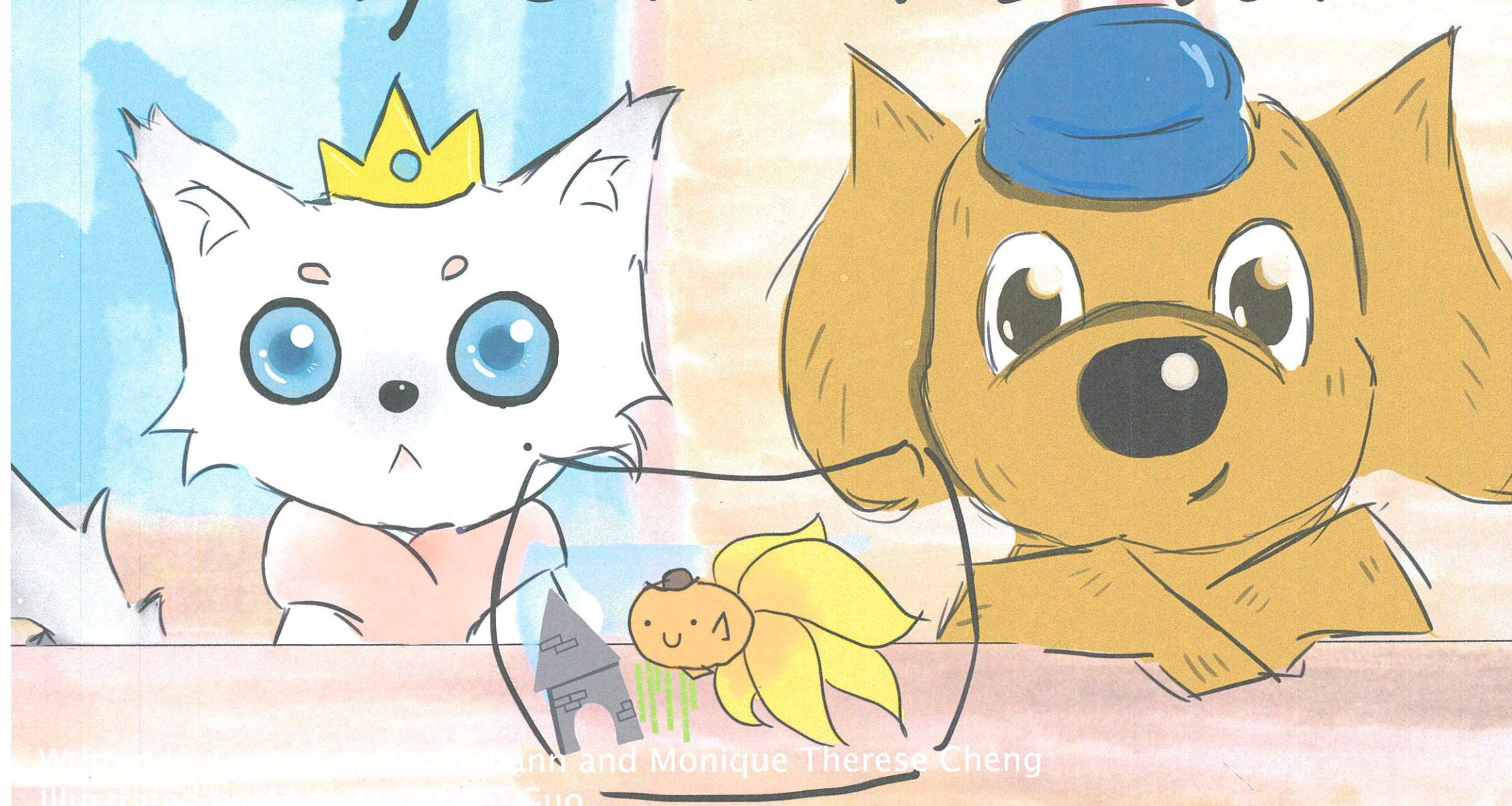

Other days she would insult Kylie "You are such a pushover"





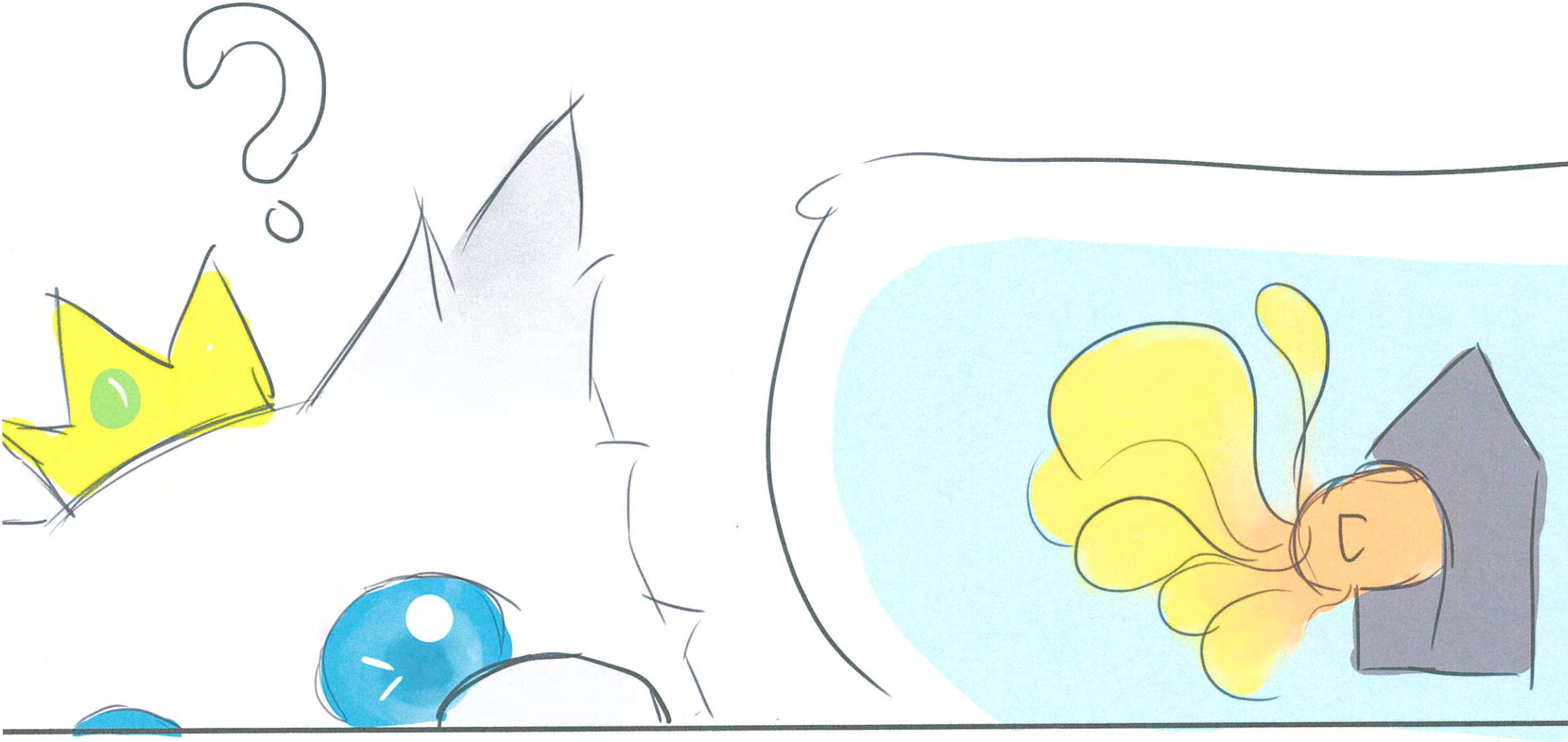
One day Kim overheard Kylie and her friends talking about her, in a rant
"Oh my God! Her fur is so gross, I can't!"



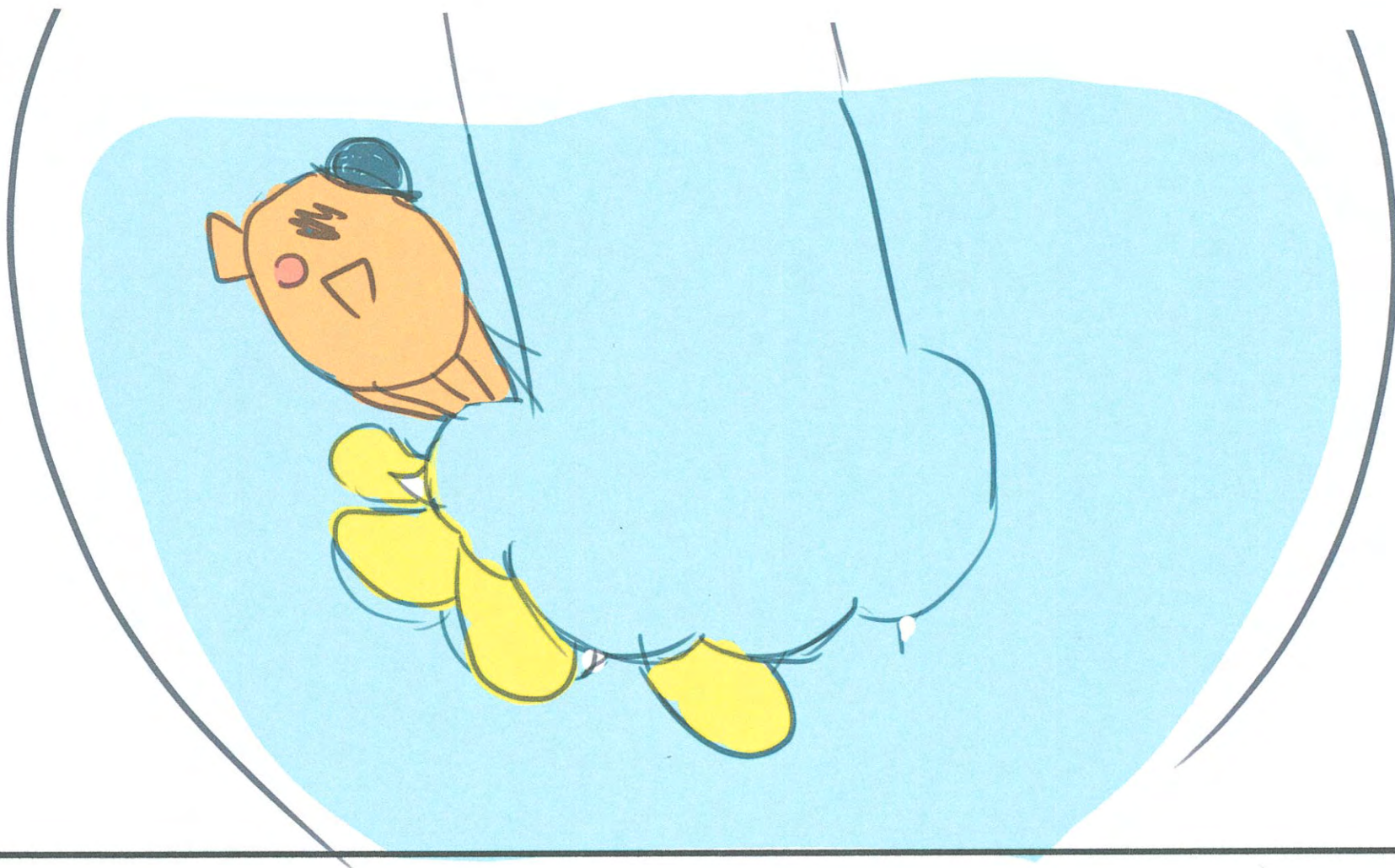
This made Kim very sad
But it also made her very mad

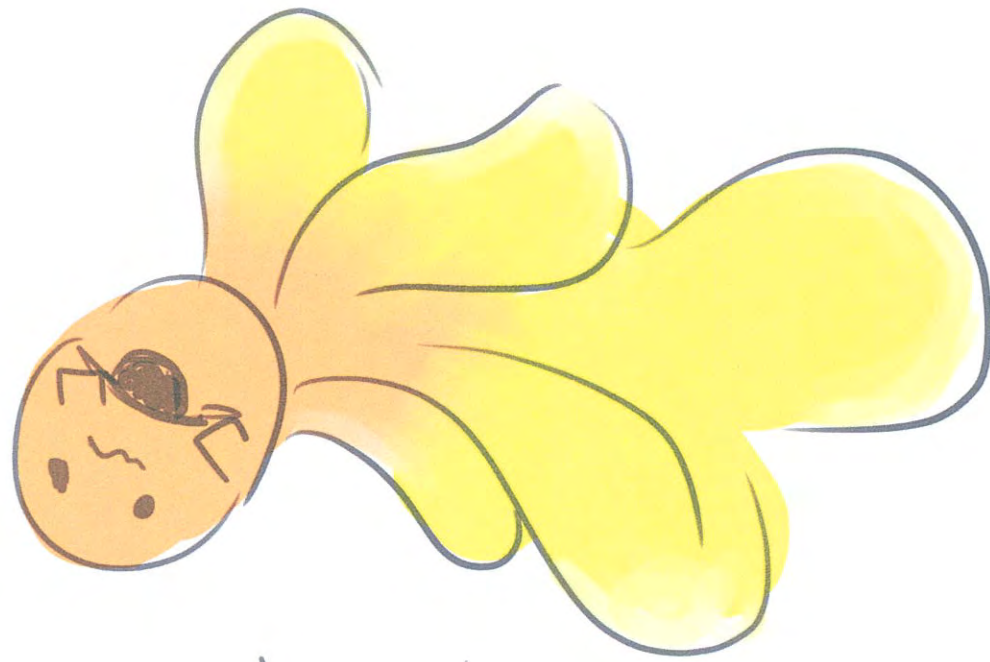


The very next day she went up to them and asked, "What do you have against me? Why do you hate me so much?"

"What in the world?" Kylie asked in a moment of baffle.

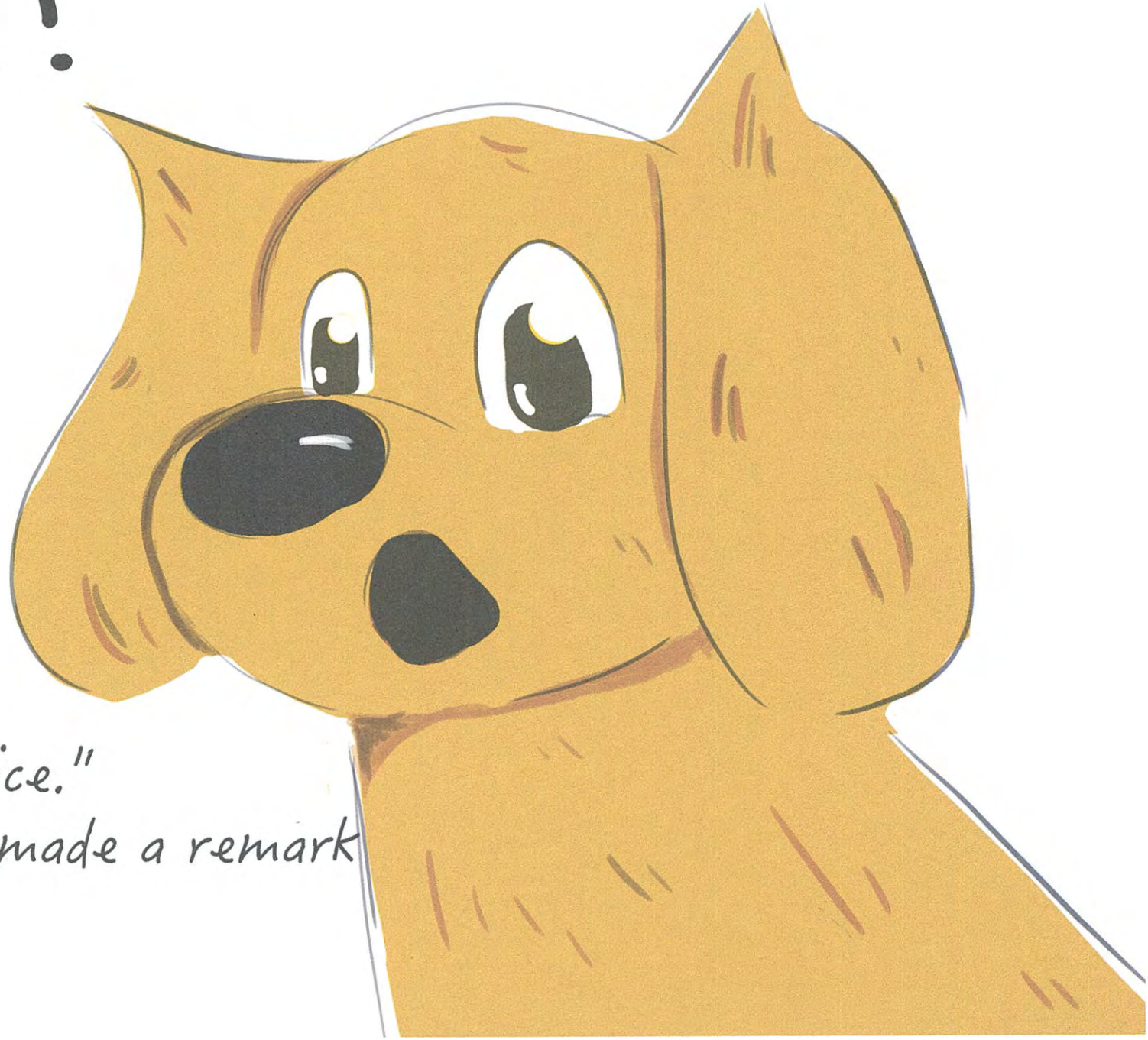




She threw Kylie up and down,

"But you are hurting Kylie!"


"So...She is just a fish. Who cares about her?" Kim sneered back, slyly

STOP!

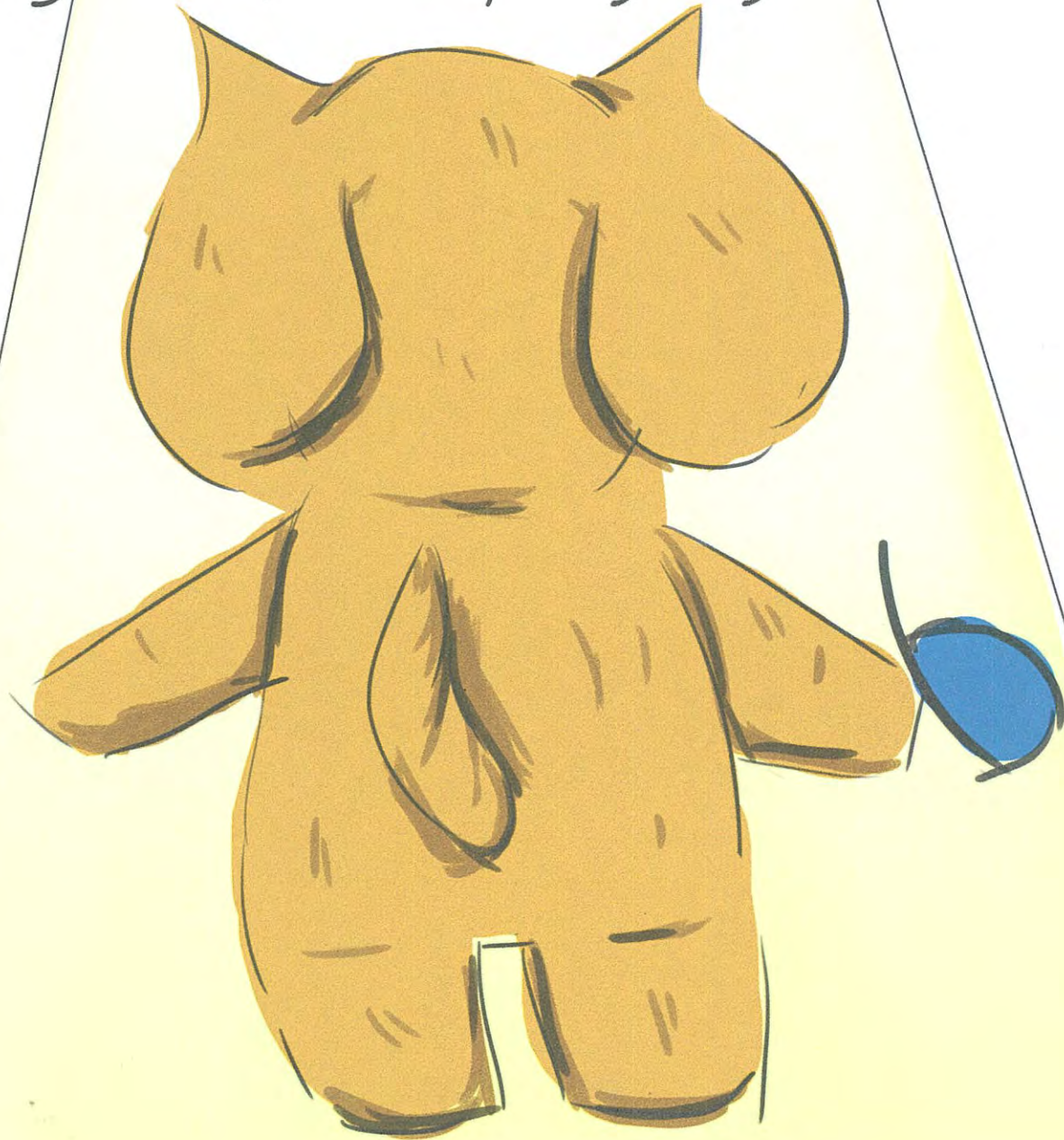




"But she is always so mean to me,

"You guys need to stop arguing over this stuff!"

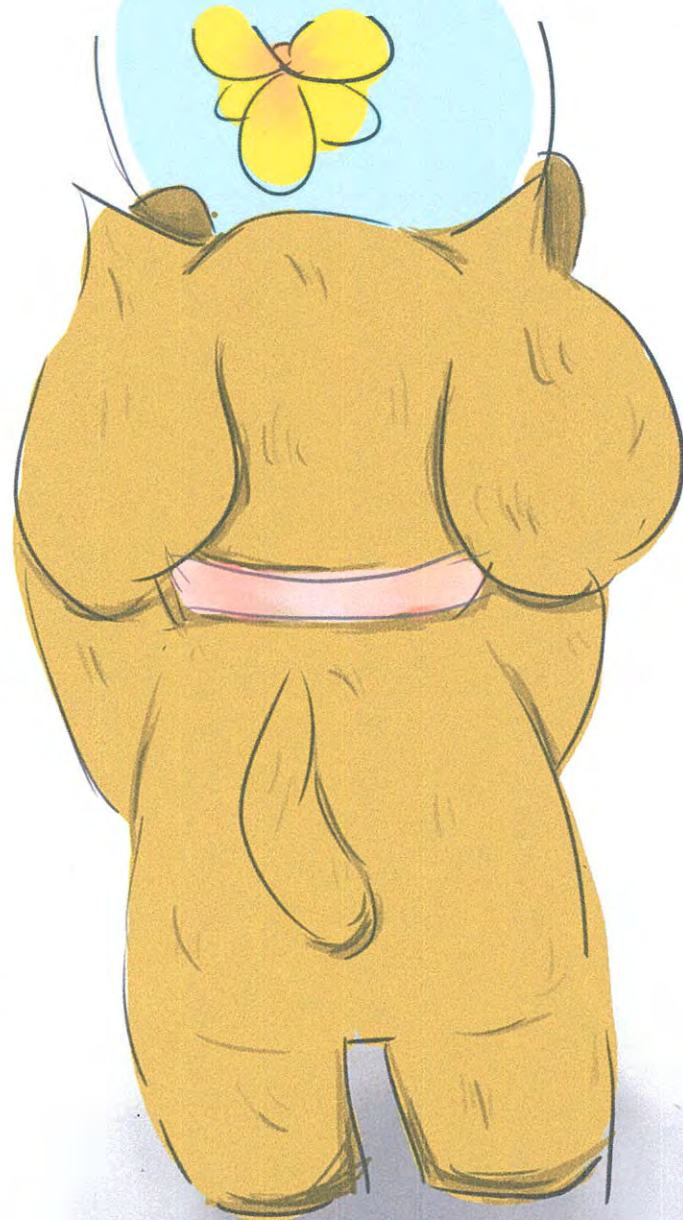


"You're right, I'm sorry" Kim begun,


