






Out of nowhere, a dragon named Draco goes up to Finn and says, "What are you doing here? You will never be chosen.

Ivy the snake is so daring!


Snowy the seal is so charming!

I'm none of those things! How can I compare?




"That isss ssso mean of Draco to sssay," hisses Ivy.

Cherry angrily.





"Let's be kind to Finn!"

Finn sees the other animals together, and thinks that they are talking about him behind his back.


"They don't like me too?" He thinks sadly.








Discouraged, Finn decides to leave. He will not audition anymore.



"Finn! Where are you going?"








"No, Finn!

"And you're just so cute! Cute! Cute!"






Finn cheers up with their words!

He dances!






But Draco is not.





A few weeks later...




"Here comes the ringmaster!"


The crowd exclaims.

The animals move aside for Draco and Finn.







"They must be cheering for me," Draco says smugly.

Draco looks at the list first, trying to find his name.








"There is no need, Finn. Look!" Draco says with a frown.

He lets Finn look at the list of names.




Ringmaster! Finn


He got in!
