Happy National Day and have a good holiday!

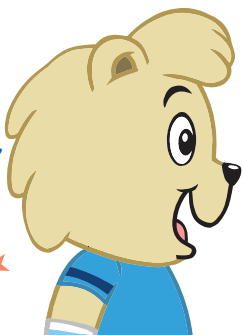

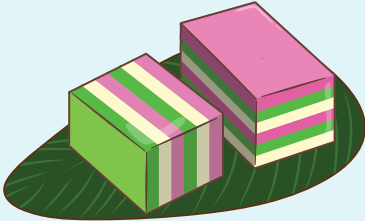

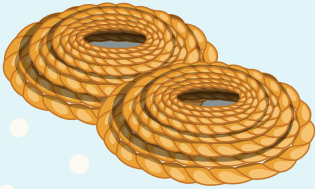

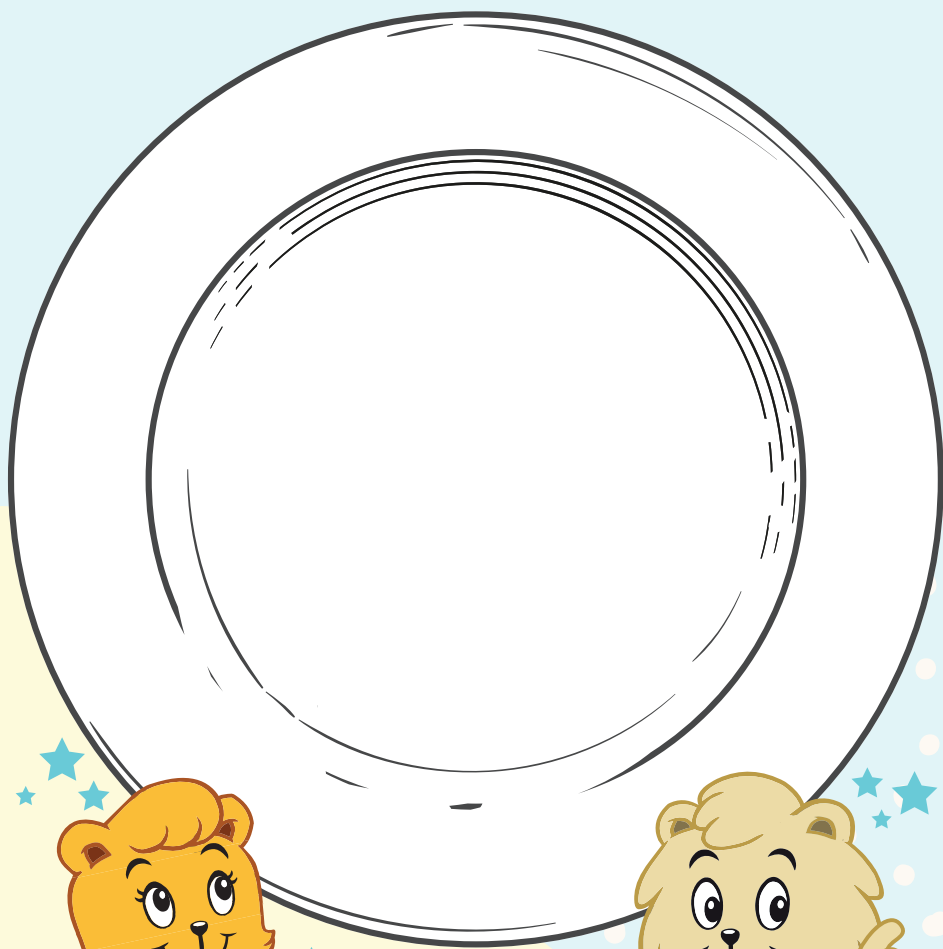

# LET'S PLAY SNAKES AND LADDERS TOGETHER!

## HOW TO PLAY

3. If you land at the bottom of a ladder, skip ahead by climbing up the ladder.
4. If you land on a snake tail, slide back down.
5. You must land exactly on the last square to win.

- 22** – You snatched someone's colour pencils without asking. That was not kind!
- 27** – Oh no! You broke your classmate's ruler but did not have the courage to apologise.
- 31** – You saw your friend crying after a fall but you did not offer your help!



# LADDERS

- 1** - Good job! You taught a friend something new.
- 4** - Great! You showed care to someone who was injured.
- 7** - Awesome! You thanked your family members for taking care of you.
- 23** - That's the way! You asked a friend if he wants to play together.
