SHER + 20 August 2021


I had a lot of fun drawing with Kalle today! She helped me with my drawing. Thank you Kalle!

Today, my teacher read a story about People giving food to others who needed food. I want to help others too! Maybe my family and I can do something like this as well!












DELIVERY DRAMA

Get creative with your family!


Did you know that we can make new toys and games using recyclable materials that can be found around us?
