Suddenly, Ava has an idea!
















Ava has an idea. She presses some buttons. A beam catches all the rocks that are floating.









But something is wrong!

The planet is crying, with big blue tears.








Ava brings Mr Moon to Mrs Blue. The two spin with joy.

Oh dear, her rocket is damaged!






How will she ever get home?

As she is about to give up, she hears three voices.


"I can give you electricity!"

At last, her rocket is fixed! But, there is still one problem.




"I'm still lost!"


