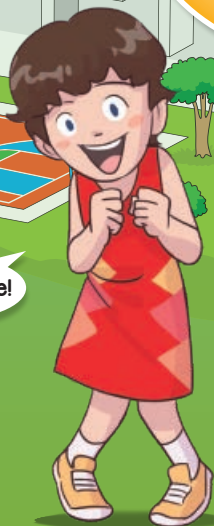

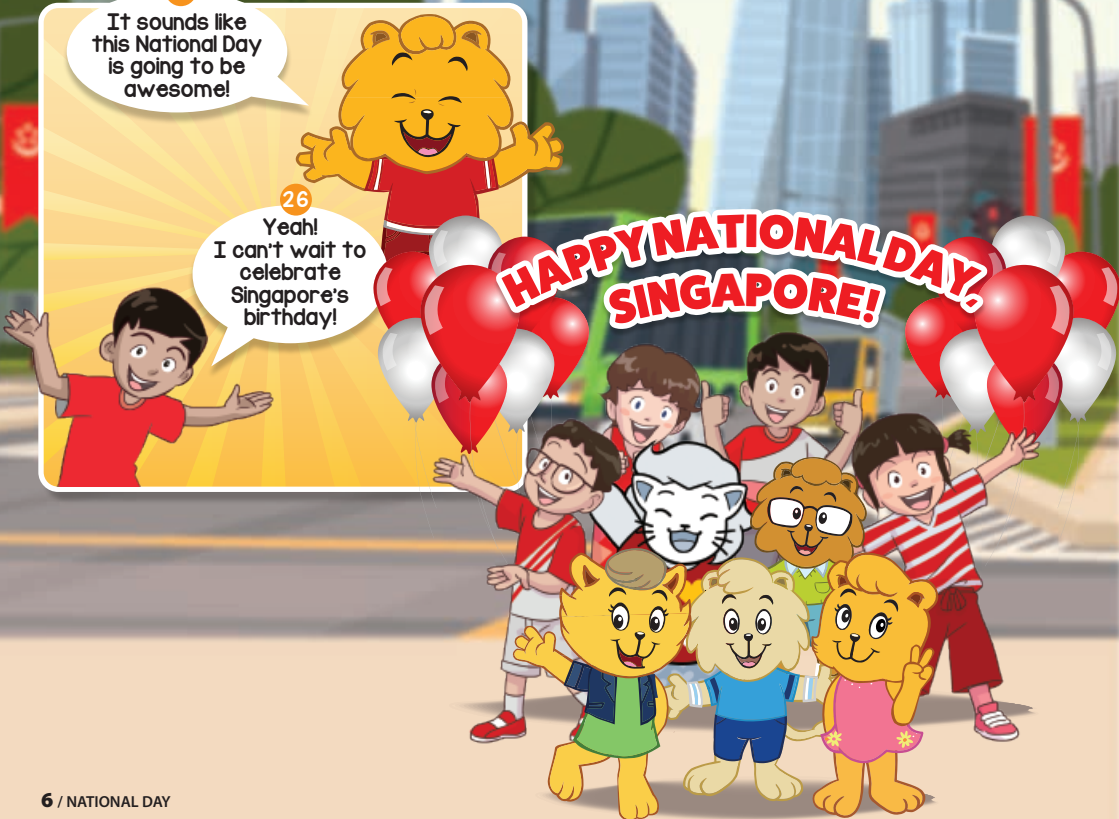

LOGO DESIGN



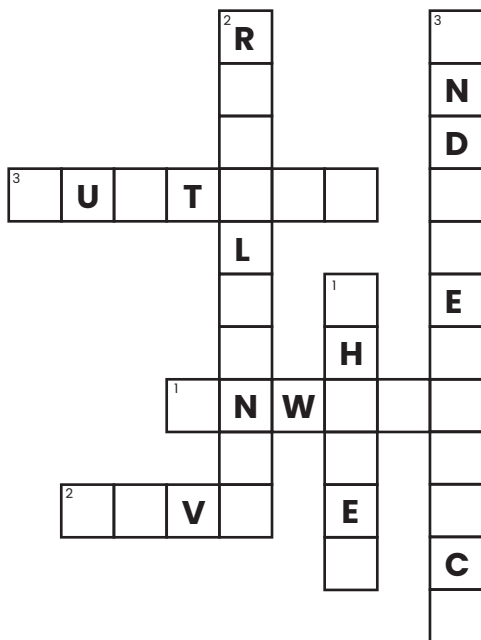
Logo

We've come so far and now it's time to

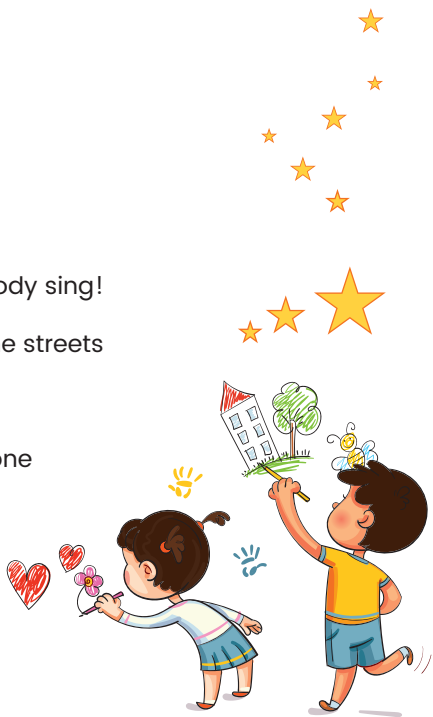

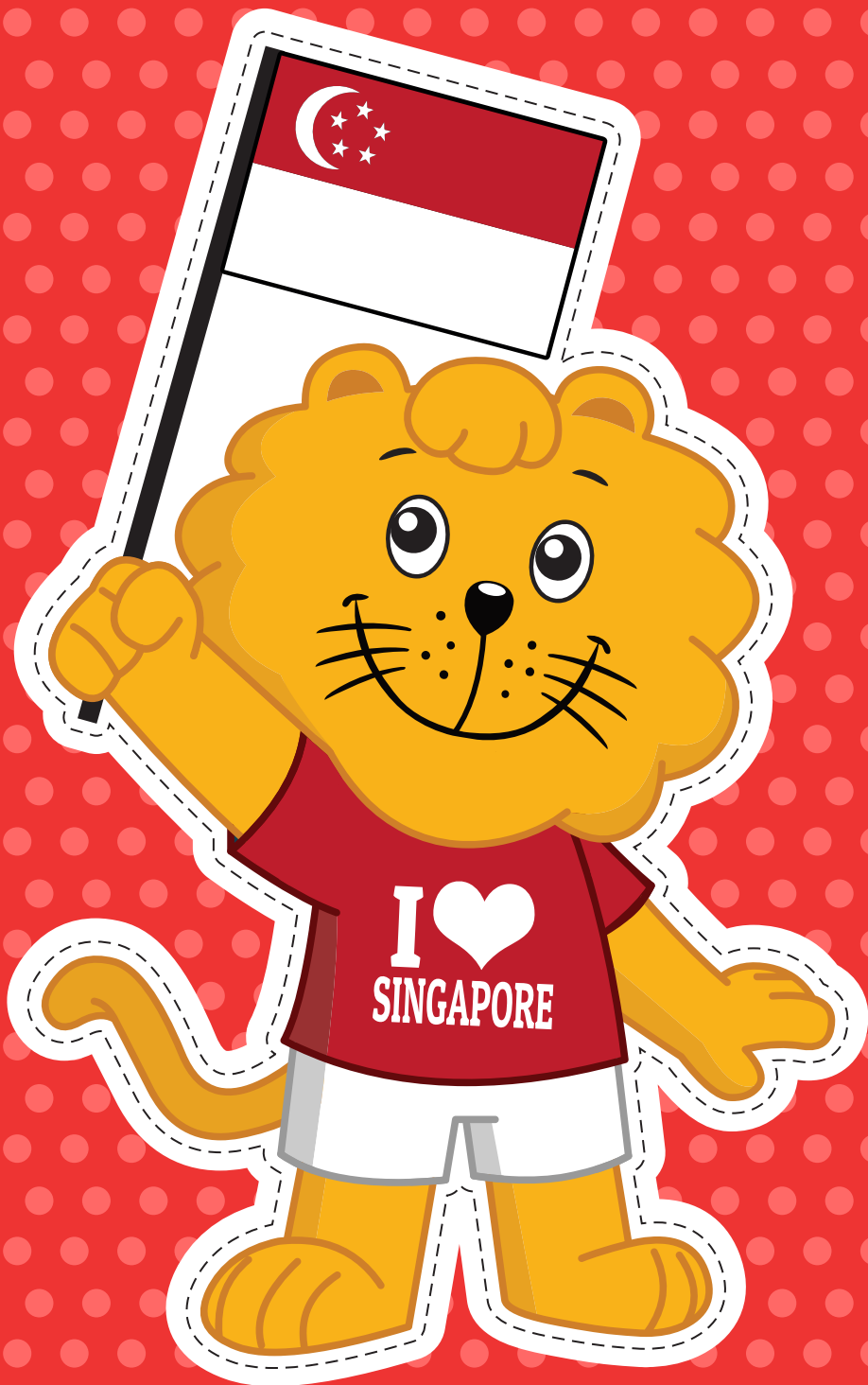
