

Families also watched the Kindness Cubbies perform and joined in the K-I-N-D-N-E-S-S Dance!



In Singapore, "Celebrating Our Grands" Day on 7 October is a day to honour and thank our grandparents for loving, caring and supporting us. How would you make this day special for your grandparents?

- The first player who makes it past the 'FINISH' square wins!







My parents have taught me to be respectful to all cultures and open to all cuisines. This is racial and social harmony to me.




DEAR SINGA,




THE GREAT FOODIE
